A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Criminal Law – Criminal Gangs – Underlying Crime**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of “underlying crime” as used in certain
4 provisions of law concerning criminal gang offenses to include misdemeanor
5 assault, malicious destruction, human trafficking, receiving earnings of a
6 prostitute, and betting, wagering, and gambling; and generally relating to
7 criminal gangs.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Criminal Law**

4 9–305 of this article; [or]
- 5 (3) a felony violation of § 5–133 of the Public Safety Article; **OR**
- 6 (4) **ANY VIOLATION OF § 3–203, § 6–301, § 11–303, § 11–304, OR §**
7 **12–102 OF THIS ARTICLE.**

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 2010.
