BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 17 Article - Family Law 18

20 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PROVIDER" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 21 5–712 OF THIS SUBTITLE.



- 1 (B) THE DEPARTMENT OR LOCAL DEPARTMENT SHALL NOTIFY THE 2 PRIMARY CARE PHYSICIAN OF A CHILD OR A PROVIDER WHO IS PROVIDING 3 ONGOING CARE TO A CHILD OF:
- 4 (1) THE INITIATION OF AN ASSESSMENT, AN INVESTIGATION, OR A
 5 PROVISION OF SERVICES BY A LOCAL DEPARTMENT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE AND
 6 THE REASON FOR THE ASSESSMENT, INVESTIGATION, OR PROVISION OF
 7 SERVICES TO THE CHILD;
- 8 (2) THE DEVELOPMENT OF A SERVICE PLAN FOR THE CHILD AND 9 THE CHILD'S FAMILY;
- 10 (3) THE FINAL STATUS OF ANY ASSESSMENT, INVESTIGATION, OR 11 ALTERNATIVE RESPONSE AND THE DETERMINATION OR FINDINGS OF THAT 12 ASSESSMENT, INVESTIGATION, OR ALTERNATIVE RESPONSE; AND
- 13 (4) ANY CHANGES TO OR THE CLOSURE OF AN ASSESSMENT, AN INVESTIGATION, OR ANY OTHER PROVISION OF SERVICES.
- 15 (C) IF REQUESTED BY THE PRIMARY CARE PHYSICIAN OF A CHILD OR A
 16 PROVIDER WHO IS PROVIDING ONGOING CARE TO A CHILD, THE DEPARTMENT
 17 OR LOCAL DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE TO THE PHYSICIAN OR PROVIDER:
- 18 (1) INFORMATION REGARDING THE CONDITION AND WELL-BEING 19 OF THE CHILD AND THE PROGRESS AND OUTCOME OF AN INVESTIGATION 20 UNDER THIS SUBTITLE;
- 21 (2) PROTECTIVE SERVICES RECORDS REGARDING THE CHILD AND
 22 ANY OTHER CHILD IN THE CHILD'S HOUSEHOLD IF THE INFORMATION RELATES
 23 TO THE MEDICAL EVALUATION AND CARE OF THE CHILD; AND
- 24 (3) THE IDENTITY OF OTHER PROVIDERS PROVIDING CARE TO 25 THE CHILD IN ORDER TO OBTAIN THE CHILD'S MEDICAL RECORDS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2014.
