Task Force to Study a Promise Scholarship Program in Maryland

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Task Force to Study a Promise Scholarship Program 4 in Maryland; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Task Force; 5 prohibiting a member of the Task Force from receiving certain compensation, but 6 authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Task Force to 7 study and make recommendations regarding certain matters; requiring the Task 8 Force to report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and the General 9 Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and 10 generally relating to the Task Force to Study a Promise Scholarship Program in Maryland. 11
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 13 That:
- 14 (a) There is a Task Force to Study a Promise Scholarship Program in Maryland.
- 15 (b) The Task Force consists of the following members:
- 16 (1) two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of 17 the Senate:
- 18 (2) two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of 19 the House;
- 20 (3) the Governor, or the Governor's designee;
- 21 (4) the Secretary of Higher Education, or the Secretary's designee;

- 3 (g) On or before January 1, 2017, the Task Force shall report its findings and 4 recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State 5 Government Article, the General Assembly.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2016. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of May 31, 2017, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
