BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Commercial Law Section 13-101, 13-301(1), (2), (5), (8), and (9), 13-303(5) and (6), and 13-401(a) and Annotated Code of Maryland (2013 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement) BY adding to Article – Commercial Law Section 13–303(7) Annotated Code of Maryland (2013 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement)



"COMMODITY" MEANS GOODS, WARES, MERCHANDISE, MACHINERY, 14 (C) SUPPLIES, OR ANY OTHER ARTICLES IN TRADE OR COMMERCE. 15 16 [(c)] **(**D**)** "Consumer" means an actual or prospective purchaser, lessee, or (1) recipient of consumer goods, consumer services, consumer realty, or consumer credit. 17 (2)"Consumer" includes: 18 A co-obligor or surety for a consumer; 19 (i) 20 A licensee or recipient of computer information or computer (ii) 21programs under a consumer contract as defined in § 22–102 of this article; 22 (iii) An individual who sells or offers for sale to a merchant consumer 23goods or consumer realty that the individual acquired primarily for personal, household, family, or agricultural purposes; or 2425A fraternal, religious, civic, patriotic, educational, or charitable (iv) 26 organization that purchases, rents, or leases goods or services for the benefit of the 27 members of the organization. 28 "Consumer credit", "consumer debts", "consumer goods", [(d)] **(E)** (1) "consumer realty", and "consumer services" mean, respectively, credit, debts or obligations, 29

- 5 [(k)] (L) "Unfair, abusive, or deceptive trade practice" has the meaning stated in Subtitle 3 of this title.

- 8 Unfair, abusive, or deceptive trade practices include any:
- 9 (1) False, falsely disparaging, or misleading oral or written statement, visual description, or other representation of any kind which has the capacity, tendency, or effect of deceiving or misleading [consumers];

- 13 (i) [Consumer goods] GOODS, [consumer] realty, or [consumer] 14 services have a sponsorship, approval, accessory, characteristic, ingredient, use, benefit, or quantity which they do not have;
- 16 (ii) A merchant has a sponsorship, approval, status, affiliation, or connection which [he] THE MERCHANT does not have;
- 18 (iii) Deteriorated, altered, reconditioned, reclaimed, or secondhand 19 consumer goods are original or new; or
- 20 (iv) [Consumer goods] GOODS, [consumer] realty, or [consumer] 21 services are of a particular standard, quality, grade, style, or model which they are not;
