A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Safety – Crime of Violence – Witness Intimidation**

3 FOR the purpose of altering a certain definition of “crime of violence” to include felony
4 witness intimidation; and generally relating to crimes of violence.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Public Safety**

18 5–101.

19 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

20 (c) “Crime of violence” means:

21 (1) abduction;

- 1 (2) arson in the first degree;
- 2 (3) assault in the first or second degree;
- 3 (4) burglary in the first, second, or third degree;
- 4 (5) carjacking and armed carjacking;
- 5 (6) escape in the first degree;
- 6 (7) kidnapping;
- 7 (8) voluntary manslaughter;
- 8 (9) maiming as previously proscribed under former Article 27, § 386 of the
9 Code;
- 10 (10) mayhem as previously proscribed under former Article 27, § 384 of the
11 Code;
- 12 (11) murder in the first or second degree;
- 13 (12) rape in the first or second degree;
- 14 (13) robbery;
- 15 (14) robbery with a dangerous weapon;
- 16 (15) sexual offense in the first, second, or third degree;
- 17 (16) home invasion under § 6–202(b) of the Criminal Law Article;
- 18 (17) a felony offense under Title 3, Subtitle 11 of the Criminal Law Article;
- 19 **(18) FELONY WITNESS INTIMIDATION UNDER § 9–302, § 9–303, OR §**
20 **9–305 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE;**
- 21 [(18)] **(19)** an attempt to commit any of the crimes listed in items (1)
22 through [(17)] **(18)** of this subsection; or
- 23 [(19)] **(20)** assault with intent to commit any of the crimes listed in items
24 (1) through [(17)] **(18)** of this subsection or a crime punishable by imprisonment for more
25 than 1 year.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
27 October 1, 2020.
