- 20 MEMBERS OF THE PARTY AT THE TIME OF THE LAST STATEWIDE GENERAL
- 21 ELECTION.
- 22 (B) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW, THE MEMBERS OF A
- 23 STATE BOARD OR COMMISSION APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR SHALL

2	MEMBERS, AT LEAST ONE MEMBER WHO IS A REGISTERED VOTER IN THE STATE
3	AND IS NOT REGISTERED AS A MEMBER OF THE MAJORITY PARTY: OR

- 4 (2) IF THE BOARD OR COMMISSION HAS 10 OR MORE MEMBERS, 5 AT LEAST TWO MEMBERS WHO ARE REGISTERED VOTERS IN THE STATE AND 6 ARE NOT REGISTERED AS MEMBERS OF THE MAJORITY PARTY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2013.
