Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services – Reinvestment of Savings to Prisoner Reentry Programs

FOR the purpose of requiring, on or before a certain date, the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services to report to the Governor and the General Assembly on the savings it has achieved through the efficient use of resources and how these savings may be reinvested in proven prisoner reentry programs, as recommended by the final report of the Task Force on Prisoner Reentry; stating the intent of the General Assembly that certain savings be incorporated in the State budget for a certain fiscal year; and generally relating to prisoner reentry.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That on or before August 1, 2013, the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services shall report to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly on the savings it has achieved through the efficient use of resources and how these savings may be reinvested in proven prisoner reentry programs, as recommended by the final report of the Task Force on Prisoner Reentry.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the General Assembly that the savings reinvestments recommended in the report of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services be incorporated in the fiscal year 2015 State budget.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2013.
