BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Education 16 7-431. 17 18 (A) Each county board shall provide each student in grades six through twelve 19 with the telephone number of the Maryland Youth Crisis Hotline by: 20 (1)Printing the telephone number prominently in the school handbook; 21 and 22 (2) Printing the telephone number on a student's school identification card, if provided. 23



- 1 (B) BEGINNING IN THE 2026–2027 SCHOOL YEAR, EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL PROVIDE EACH STUDENT IN GRADES SIX THROUGH TWELVE WITH THE TELEPHONE NUMBERS OF THE 988 SUICIDE AND CRISIS LIFELINE AND THE SAFE SCHOOLS MARYLAND ANONYMOUS TIP LINE BY:
- 5 (1) PRINTING THE TELEPHONE NUMBERS PROMINENTLY IN THE 6 SCHOOL HANDBOOK; AND
- 7 (2) PRINTING THE TELEPHONE NUMBERS ON A STUDENT'S SCHOOL 8 IDENTIFICATION CARD, IF PROVIDED.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 10 1, 2024.
