12 13	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 17 18	(a) In this section, "HOV lane" means a high occupancy vehicle lane, the use of which is restricted by a traffic control device during specified times to vehicles carrying at least a specified number of occupants.
19 20	(b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, a person may not drive a vehicle in an HOV lane unless authorized by a traffic control device.

The following vehicles may be driven in an HOV lane at all times

- 2 (iii) A plug–in electric drive vehicle displaying a valid permit issued 3 under § 25–108 of this article; and
- 4 (iv) A tow truck that is properly registered in accordance with § 5 13–920 of this article and is using any visual signal that meets the requirements of § 6 22–218 of this article while responding to a call for service if an appropriate law 7 enforcement agency has authorized the tow truck operator to use HOV lanes.
- 8 (2) A qualified hybrid vehicle displaying a valid permit issued under § 9 25–108 of this article may be driven in the portion of U.S. Route 50 designated as an HOV 10 lane, between Interstate 95/Interstate 495 and U.S. Route 301, at all times regardless of 11 the number of passengers in or on the vehicle.
- 12 (3) FOR THE PORTION OF U.S. ROUTE 50 DESIGNATED AS AN HOV
 13 LANE, BETWEEN INTERSTATE 95/INTERSTATE 495 AND U.S. ROUTE 301, THE
 14 REQUIREMENT THAT A VEHICLE HAVE MULTIPLE PASSENGERS IN THE VEHICLE
 15 APPLIES ONLY MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY BETWEEN 6 A.M. AND 9 A.M. AND
 16 BETWEEN 4 P.M. AND 7 P.M.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 October 1, 2018.
