A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Child Welfare Training Act of 2010**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Human Resources to identify State
4 funds that are used for the training of the child welfare workforce, in the public
5 and private sector, in order to receive the maximum amount of federal matching
6 funds available to the Department under Title IV–E of the Social Security Act,
7 in accordance with a certain federal law; and generally relating to funding for
8 the training of the child welfare workforce.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Family Law**

17 **5–1312.**

18 **THE DEPARTMENT SHALL IDENTIFY ALL STATE FUNDS THAT ARE USED**
19 **FOR THE TRAINING OF THE CHILD WELFARE WORKFORCE, IN THE PUBLIC AND**
20 **PRIVATE SECTOR, IN ORDER TO RECEIVE THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF FEDERAL**
21 **MATCHING FUNDS AVAILABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT UNDER TITLE IV–E OF**
22 **THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ADOPTION**
23 **ASSISTANCE AND CHILD WELFARE ACT OF 1980, P.L. 96–272, AS AMENDED.**
