## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Income Tax – Subtraction Modification – Maryland Transportation Authority**  
3 **Police**

4 FOR the purpose of altering a subtraction modification under the Maryland income tax for  
5 certain law enforcement officers to include law enforcement officers who are  
6 members of the Maryland Transportation Authority Police and reside in a political  
7 subdivision with a certain crime rate; providing for the application of this Act; and  
8 generally relating to a subtraction modification under the Maryland income tax for  
9 members of the Maryland Transportation Authority Police.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **Article – Tax – General**

24 (a) To the extent included in federal adjusted gross income, the amounts under

1 this section are subtracted from the federal adjusted gross income of a resident to determine  
2 Maryland adjusted gross income.

3 (cc) (1) (i) In this subsection the following words have the meanings  
4 indicated.

5 (ii) “Law enforcement agency” has the meaning stated in § 3–201 of  
6 the Public Safety Article.

7 (iii) “Law enforcement officer” means an individual who:

8 1. in an official capacity is authorized by law to make arrests;  
9 and

10 2. is a member of a law enforcement agency, including a law  
11 enforcement officer who serves in a probationary status or at the pleasure of the appointing  
12 authority of a county or municipal corporation.

13 (iv) “Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission” means  
14 the unit established under § 3–202 of the Public Safety Article.

15 (2) The subtraction under subsection (a) of this section includes the first  
16 \$5,000 of income earned by a law enforcement officer if:

17 (i) 1. the law enforcement officer resides in the political  
18 subdivision in which the law enforcement officer is employed; and

19 [(ii)] 2. the crime rate in the political subdivision exceeds the  
20 State’s crime rate; **OR**

21 **(II) 1. THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IS A MEMBER OF**  
22 **THE MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY POLICE; AND**

23 **2. THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER RESIDES IN A**  
24 **POLITICAL SUBDIVISION IN WHICH THE CRIME RATE EXCEEDS THE STATE’S CRIME**  
25 **RATE.**

26 (3) On or before September 1, 2016, and every 3 years thereafter, the  
27 Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission shall certify to the Comptroller the  
28 political subdivisions in which the crime rate exceeds the State’s crime rate.

29 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED,** That this Act shall take effect July  
30 1, 2018, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after December 31, 2017.
