17 **2–216.** 

### 18 EACH REGISTER, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MARYLAND REGISTERS OF 19 WILLS ASSOCIATION, SHALL OFFER A METHOD BY WHICH AN INDIVIDUAL WITHOUT 20 GOVERNMENT–ISSUED IDENTIFICATION MAY PROVE THE INDIVIDUAL'S IDENTITY AS
