CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Motor Vehicles – Duplicate Driver’s Licenses – Victims of Robbery or Theft**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration, when processing an
4 application for a duplicate license of a victim of a robbery or theft whose license is
5 taken during the robbery or theft, to issue the duplicate license free of charge under
6 certain circumstances; and generally relating to duplicate driver’s licenses and
7 victims of robbery or theft.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Transportation**

16 16–114.

1 (a) In this section, "mutilated" includes any imperfection of or in a driver's license,
2 after its issuance, that renders it unsuitable for identification purposes or for verifying its
3 authenticity and validity.

4 (b) If a driver's license is lost, stolen, mutilated, or destroyed, the licensee
5 immediately shall apply for and, after furnishing information satisfactory to the
6 Administration and payment of the required fee, is entitled to obtain a duplicate license. If
7 the duplicate license being applied for is of a type requiring a photo and the licensee is
8 temporarily absent from this State, the Administration may issue a regular license bearing
9 the notation that it is valid without a photo until 15 days after the licensee first returns to
10 this State.

11 (c) A licensee who is at least 21 years may apply for a duplicate license that
12 includes a frontal photograph of the licensee.

13 (d) If a person recovers an original license for which a duplicate has been issued,
14 the person promptly shall surrender the original license to the Administration.

15 **(E) IF A VICTIM OF A ROBBERY OR THEFT WHOSE LICENSE IS TAKEN DURING**
16 **THE ROBBERY OR THEFT PRESENTS A POLICE REPORT OF THE ROBBERY OR THEFT**
17 **WHEN APPLYING FOR A DUPLICATE LICENSE, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ISSUE A**
18 **DUPLICATE LICENSE FREE OF CHARGE.**

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 October 1, 2019.
