BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 5 6 Article – Estates and Trusts 7 Section 14.5–705 Annotated Code of Maryland 8 9 (2022 Replacement Volume and 2024 Supplement) 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 11 12 **Article - Estates and Trusts** 14.5 - 705.13 14 (a) A trustee may resign [with]: ON AT LEAST 30 DAYS' NOTICE TO: 15 **(1)** 16 **(I)** THE QUALIFIED BENEFICIARIES; 17 (II) THE SETTLOR, IF LIVING; 18 (III) ALL COTRUSTEES; AND



## 1 (IV) ANY PERSON THAT HAS A RIGHT TO REPLACE OR APPOINT A SUCCESSOR TO THE RESIGNING TRUSTEE; OR

- 3 **(2) WITH** the approval of the court.
- 4 (b) In approving a resignation of a trustee, the court may issue orders and impose conditions reasonably necessary for the protection of the trust property.
- 6 (c) Liability of a resigning trustee or of a surety on the bond of the trustee for acts or omissions of the trustee is not discharged or affected by the resignation of the trustee.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2025.
