A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

State Finance and Procurement – Chesapeake Bay Watershed States – Expenses and Contracts (Quit Polluting My Bay Act of 2022)

- $\mathbf{5}$ FOR the purpose of requiring the Standard State Travel Regulations adopted under certain 6 provisions of law to prohibit the reimbursement for travel expenses related to travel 7 to a certain state for which the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has identified 8 certain pollution source sectors at a certain level of oversight; prohibiting a certain 9 public body from awarding a certain procurement contract for goods or services to a 10 certain business from a certain state for which the U.S. Environmental Protection 11 Agency has identified certain pollution source sectors at a certain level of oversight; 12and generally relating to sources of pollution to the Chesapeake Bay and prohibited 13 activities under the Standard State Travel Regulations and State procurement law.

- 25 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 26 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 (a) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
4 INDICATED.

5 (2) "BACKSTOP ACTIONS LEVEL" MEANS A LEVEL OF OVERSIGHT FOR 6 A POLLUTION SOURCE SECTOR IN A STATE IDENTIFIED BY THE U.S. 7 ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AFTER IDENTIFYING SUBSTANTIAL 8 CONCERNS WITH A STATE'S STRATEGY TO IMPLEMENT GOALS UNDER THE BAY 9 TMDL.

(3) (I) "BAY TMDL" MEANS THE TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOAD
(TMDL) FOR THE CHESAPEAKE BAY ESTABLISHED UNDER THE FEDERAL CLEAN
WATER ACT BY THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY ON DECEMBER
29, 2010.

14(II) "BAY TMDL" INCLUDES ANY MODIFICATION TO THE BAY15TMDL MADE BY THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY.

16 **(B)** (1) On the recommendation of the Comptroller, the Board shall adopt 17 regulations in accordance with Title 10, Subtitle 1 of the State Government Article covering 18 matters of business administration in the units of the State government.

19 (2) The regulations adopted under this section may include regulations 20 that establish:

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(i) uniform rates of mileage allowance; and

(ii) the terms and renewals of bonds furnished by State officials andemployees.

(3) THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER

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SUBTITLE 9. CHESAPEAKE BAY WATERSHED STATES.

3 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 4 INDICATED.

5 (B) "BACKSTOP ACTIONS LEVEL" MEANS A LEVEL OF OVERSIGHT FOR A 6 POLLUTION SOURCE SECTOR IN A STATE IDENTIFIED BY THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL 7 PROTECTION AGENCY AFTER IDENTIFYING SUBSTANTIAL CONCERNS WITH A 8 STATE'S STRATEGY TO IMPLEMENT GOALS UNDER THE BAY TMDL.

9 (C) (1) "BAY TMDL" MEANS THE TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOAD (TMDL) 10 FOR THE CHESAPEAKE BAY ESTABLISHED UNDER THE FEDERAL CLEAN WATER 11 ACT BY THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY ON DECEMBER 29, 2010.

12 (2) "BAY TMDL" INCLUDES ANY MODIFICATION TO THE BAY TMDL 13 MADE BY THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY.

14 (D) "PUBLIC BODY" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 17–701 OF THIS TITLE.

15 **17–902.**

A PUBLIC BODY MAY NOT AWARD A PROCUREMENT CONTRACT FOR GOODS OR SERVICES TO A BUSINESS FROM A STATE FOR WHICH THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, IN ITS MOST RECENT OVERSIGHT OF WATERSHED IMPLEMENTATION PLANS AND MILESTONES IN THE CHESAPEAKE BAY WATERSHED, HAS IDENTIFIED TWO OR MORE POLLUTION SOURCE SECTORS AT A BACKSTOP ACTIONS LEVEL OF OVERSIGHT, IF THE BUSINESS:

- 22 (1) HAS ITS PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS IN THAT STATE;
- 23 (2) HAS AT LEAST 51% OF ITS EMPLOYEES LOCATED IN THAT STATE;
- 24 (3) IS INCORPORATED IN THAT STATE; OR
- 25 (4) REPORTED ITS PRIMARY TAX LIABILITY IN THAT STATE.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 27 October 1, 2022.
