4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting, in Baltimore City, a person from selling or offering for sale  
5 ~~any vehicle that is prohibited from use in Baltimore City under any State or local~~  
6 ~~law~~ a dirt bike; establishing a certain penalty; providing that this Act does not apply  
7 to a certain transaction; and generally relating to prohibiting a person from selling  
8 or offering for sale certain vehicles in Baltimore City.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

## Article – Transportation

15-112.1.

(A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A TRANSACTION BETWEEN:

(1) A LICENSED WHOLESALE DEALER; AND

(2) A LICENSED DEALER, AN AUTOMOTIVE DISMANTLER AND RECYCLER, OR A SCRAP PROCESSOR.

~~(A) (B)~~ IN BALTIMORE CITY, A PERSON MAY NOT SELL OR OFFER FOR SALE ANY VEHICLE THAT IS PROHIBITED FROM USE IN BALTIMORE CITY UNDER ANY STATE OR LOCAL LAW A DIRT BIKE, AS DEFINED IN § 21-1128(A)(2) OF THIS ARTICLE.

~~(B) (C)~~ A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 60 DAYS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$2,000 OR BOTH \$1,000.

(a) (2) (i) “Dirt bike” means any motorcycle or similar vehicle that is not required to be registered under Title 13 of this article.

(ii) “Dirt bike” includes:

1. A motorized minibike, as defined in § 11-134.4 of this article; and

2. An all-terrain vehicle with either 3 or 4 wheels.

(iii) “Dirt bike” does not include:

1. A moped, as defined in § 11-134.1 of this article; or

2. A motor scooter, as defined in § 11-134.5 of this article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2015.
