A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore County – Alcoholic Beverages – Racetrack License**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the racetrack beer and wine license issued in Baltimore
4 County; altering the fee for a racetrack beer, wine, and liquor license in the county;
5 and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Baltimore County.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

19 13–102.

20 This title applies only in Baltimore County.

21 13–1001.

1 (a) There is[:

2 (1) a racetrack beer and wine license; and

3 (2)] a racetrack beer, wine, and liquor license.

4 (b) (1) The Board may issue [a] **THE** license to the owner, concessionaire, or
5 catering organization of a licensed racing establishment, whether an individual, an
6 association, or a corporation.

7 (2) There are no residential or voting qualifications for the [licenses]
8 **LICENSE.**

9 (c) [(1) The racetrack beer and wine license authorizes the license holder to sell
10 beer and wine at one or more locations on the premises of the racing park of the license
11 holder.

12 (2)] The [racetrack beer, wine, and liquor] license authorizes the license
13 holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor at one or more locations on the premises of the racing
14 park of the license holder.

15 (d) The license fee is[:

16 (1) for a racetrack beer and wine license, \$25 for each day that the racing
17 park is open and operating; and

18 (2) for a racetrack beer, wine, and liquor license, \$50 for each day that the
19 racing park is open and operating] **\$1,000 FOR EACH CALENDAR YEAR.**

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
21 1, 2016.
