4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission to
5 include guidelines for the use of electronic control devices in a certain set of best
6 practices and standards for use of force; and generally relating to the Maryland
7 Police Training and Standards Commission.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
9 Article – Public Safety
10 Section 3–207(a)(19)
11 Annotated Code of Maryland
12 (2011 Replacement Volume and 2016 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Public Safety**

16 3–207.

2 (19) to adopt and recommend a set of best practices and standards for use of
3 force, **INCLUDING GUIDELINES FOR THE USE OF ELECTRONIC CONTROL DEVICES;**

5 October 1, 2017.
