CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Montgomery County – Board of Education Residence Districts –**  
3 **Redistricting Plan**

4 **MC 1–11SS**

5 FOR the purpose of altering the boundaries of the residence districts for the  
6 Montgomery County Board of Education; repealing a provision of law relating to  
7 the date when certain reapportioned districts become effective; making this Act  
8 an emergency measure; and generally relating to the residence districts for the  
9 Montgomery County Board of Education.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
11 Article – Education  
12 Section 3–901  
13 Annotated Code of Maryland  
14 (2008 Replacement Volume and 2011 Supplement)

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Education**

18 3–901.

19 (a) (1) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

1                   (2)    “Elected member” means 1 of the 7 elected and voting members of  
2 the Montgomery County Board or a member appointed to fill a vacancy of 1 of these 7  
3 members.

4                   (3)    “Board of Education District” means a geographic area of  
5 Montgomery County in which an elected member of the Montgomery County Board of  
6 Education must be a legal resident. The geographic area of each district is described in  
7 subsection (f) of this section. Each district shall be substantially equal in population,  
8 and the districts shall be reapportioned on the basis of each decennial census of the  
9 United States. [Reapportioned districts shall become effective for the term of office  
10 commencing after the first regular primary election held at least 15 months after the  
11 official report on population is received by the State from the Bureau of the Census.]

12                   (b)    The Montgomery County Board consists of:

13                   (1)    5 elected members, each of whom resides in a different board of  
14 education district;

15                   (2)    2 elected members who may reside anywhere in the county; and

16                   (3)    1 student member.

17                   (c)    An elected member of the county board shall be a registered voter of  
18 Montgomery County.

19                   (d)    Members of the Montgomery County Board shall be elected at the general  
20 election every 2 years as required by subsection (f) of this section.

21                   (e)    (1)    The student member shall be a bona fide resident of Montgomery  
22 County and a regularly enrolled junior or senior year student from a Montgomery  
23 County public high school.

24                   (2)    The nomination and election process shall be as agreed on by the  
25 county board and the Montgomery County region of the Maryland Association of  
26 Student Councils. This agreement shall include a process by which to replace one or  
27 both of the final candidates if they are unable to proceed in the election. Any student  
28 enrolled in a middle or high school in the Montgomery County public schools may:

29                           (i)    Nominate a student member candidate;

30                           (ii)   Vote for delegates from the student’s school, who in turn  
31 vote in a nominating convention to reduce to 2 the number of candidates for student  
32 board member if there are 3 or more candidates; and

33                           (iii)   Vote directly for 1 of the 2 remaining student board member  
34 candidates.

1           (3) The candidate receiving the second highest number of votes in the  
2 direct election shall become the alternate student member. The alternate shall serve if  
3 the student member is unable to complete his elected term.

4           (4) Except as provided in paragraphs (5), (6), and (7) of this  
5 subsection, the student member has the same rights and privileges of an elected  
6 member.

7           (5) Unless invited to attend by the affirmative vote of a majority of the  
8 county board, the student member may not attend an executive session that relates to:

9                   (i) Hearings held under § 6-202(a) of this article; or

10                   (ii) Collective bargaining.

11           (6) As provided in paragraph (7) of this subsection, the student  
12 member shall vote on all matters except those relating to:

13                   (i) § 6-202(a) of this article;

14                   (ii) Collective bargaining;

15                   (iii) Capital and operating budgets; and

16                   (iv) School closings, reopenings, and boundaries.

17           (7) On a majority vote of the elected members, the board may  
18 determine, on a case by case basis, whether a matter under consideration is covered by  
19 the exclusionary provisions listed in paragraph (6) of this subsection.

20           (f) (1) Each elected member serves for a term of 4 years beginning on  
21 December 1 after the member's election and until a successor is elected and qualifies.  
22 The terms of elected members are staggered as required by the terms of the members  
23 serving on the county board as of July 1, 1978 so that 4 members are elected in  
24 gubernatorial election years and 3 members are elected in presidential election years.

25                   (2) Elected members of the county board shall be elected by the voters  
26 of the entire county.

27                   (3) (i) Of the 3 members elected in 1992 and every 4 years  
28 thereafter, 1 shall reside in Board of Education District 2 and 1 shall reside in Board  
29 of Education District 4. The third member may reside in any part of the county.

30                   (ii) Of the 4 members elected in 1990 and every 4 years  
31 thereafter, 1 shall reside in Board of Education District 1, 1 shall reside in Board of

1 Education District 3, and 1 shall reside in Board of Education District 5. The fourth  
2 member may reside in any part of the county.

3 (iii) The descriptions of board of education districts in this  
4 subsection refer to the geographical boundaries of the election districts and the  
5 precincts:

6 1. As reviewed and certified by the Montgomery County  
7 Board of Elections or its designees, before the precinct boundaries were reported to the  
8 U.S. Bureau of the Census as part of the [2000] 2010 Census Redistricting Data  
9 Program; and

10 2. As those precinct lines are specifically shown on the  
11 P.L. 94-171 census block maps provided by the U.S. Bureau of the Census and as  
12 reviewed and corrected by the [Department of Planning] **DIVISION OF LONG-RANGE**  
13 **PLANNING OF THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS.**

14 (iv) **WHERE PRECINCTS ARE SPLIT BETWEEN BOARD OF**  
15 **EDUCATION DISTRICTS, CENSUS TRACT AND BLOCK NUMBERS, AS INDICATED**  
16 **IN THE P.L. 94-171 DATA OR SHOWN ON THE P.L. 171 CENSUS BLOCK MAPS**  
17 **PROVIDED BY THE U.S. BUREAU OF THE CENSUS AND REFERRED TO IN THIS**  
18 **SUBTITLE, ARE USED TO DEFINE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE EDUCATION**  
19 **DISTRICTS.**

20 [(iv) Board of Education District 1 consists of:

21 1. Election district 1, precincts 2 and 3;

22 2. Election district 2, precincts 1, 3, and 5;

23 3. Election district 3;

24 4. Election district 9, precincts 1, 3, 5, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13,  
25 15 through 19, 22, 23, 24, 25, 27, 28, 29, and 30;

26 5. Election district 11;

27 6. Election district 12;

28 7. That part of election district 1, precinct 1 that is  
29 generally the northern part of precinct 1 which extends from the precinct boundary  
30 north along the center of Laytonsville Olney Road, then south along the center of Field  
31 Crest Road to a line going south just west of Stream Valley Way to Rock Creek, then  
32 south along Rock Creek to its intersection with Field Crest Road, then west along the  
33 center of Field Crest Road to the precinct boundary;

1           8. That part of election district 1, precinct 4 that is  
2 generally the northern part of precinct 4 which extends from the precinct boundary,  
3 then goes west on a line just north of Hadley Farms Road and includes all streets off of  
4 Hadley Farms Drive to Chain Branch Tributary (a creek), then south along Chain  
5 Branch Tributary to the precinct boundary;

6           9. That part of election district 2, precinct 2 that is  
7 generally the northern part of precinct 2 which extends from the precinct boundary  
8 north along a line just east of Clarksburg Road to the shore of Lake Seneca and the  
9 precinct boundary;

10          10. That part of election district 6, precinct 3 that is  
11 generally the northern and southern parts of precinct 3 which extends from the  
12 precinct boundary west along the center of Great Seneca Highway to the precinct  
13 boundary, then along the precinct boundary to its intersection with Great Seneca  
14 Creek, then east–southeast along the Great Seneca Creek to the precinct boundary;

15          11. That part of election district 9, precinct 2 that is  
16 generally the northern part of precinct 2 which extends from the precinct boundary  
17 north along the center of Shady Grove Road to its intersection with the City of  
18 Rockville boundary, then north on the City of Rockville boundary to the precinct  
19 boundary;

20          12. That part of election district 9, precinct 6 that is  
21 generally the northern part of precinct 6 which extends from the precinct boundary  
22 south along the center of the Interstate 270 exit for Fields Road to the center of Fields  
23 Road, then east along the center of Fields Road to a point just west of Winners Road,  
24 then north staying just west of Winners Road to Washington Boulevard, then along  
25 the center of Washington Boulevard to its intersection with Rio Boulevard, then south  
26 along the center of Rio Boulevard to its intersection with Fields Road, then west along  
27 the center of Fields Road to the intersection at Sam Eig Highway, then continues west  
28 to the center of Crown Farm Road, then proceeds west along the center of Crown Farm  
29 Road to the intersection of Watch Hill Lane, then along a line just northwest of Crown  
30 Farm Road moves north and west to Story Drive and the intersection of County Court,  
31 then south along the center of Story Drive to the intersection with Diamondback  
32 Drive, then east along the center of Diamondback Drive to the intersection of Sam Eig  
33 Highway, then south along the center of Sam Eig Highway to the City of Gaithersburg  
34 boundary, then south and west along the City of Gaithersburg boundary to the  
35 precinct boundary;

36          13. That part of election district 9, precinct 10 that is  
37 generally the western part of precinct 10 which extends from the precinct boundary  
38 northwest along the center of B&O Railroad to Washington Grove town limits, then  
39 northeast along Washington Grove boundary to its intersection with Ridge Road, then  
40 east–northeast along the center of Ridge Road to Amity Drive, then west–northwest  
41 along the center of Amity Drive to the precinct boundary;

1                   14. That part of election district 9, precinct 20 that is  
2 generally the western part of precinct 20 which extends from the precinct boundary  
3 east–northeast along the City of Gaithersburg boundary to its intersection with  
4 Woodward's Store Road, then northwest along the center of Woodward's Store Road to  
5 the precinct boundary; and

6                   15. That part of election district 9, precinct 21 that is  
7 generally the western part of precinct 21 which extends from the precinct boundary  
8 north along the City of Gaithersburg boundary, then west–northwest along the center  
9 of Emory Grove Road to the precinct boundary.

10                   (v) Board of Education District 2 consists of:

11                   1. Election district 2, precinct 4;

12                   2. Election district 4, precincts 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 9, 11, 12,  
13 14, 16, 20, 21, 23, 25, 29, 30, and 32;

14                   3. Election district 6, precincts 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, and 7;

15                   4. Election district 9, precinct 26;

16                   5. Election district 10, precincts 1 through 6, 8, 9, 12,  
17 and 13;

18                   6. Election district 13, precincts 35, 37, 43, 45, 51, 52,  
19 and 60;

20                   7. That part of election district 2, precinct 2 that is  
21 generally the southern part of precinct 2 which extends from the precinct boundary  
22 north along a line just east of Clarksburg Road to the shore of Lake Seneca and the  
23 precinct boundary;

24                   8. That part of election district 4, precinct 15 that is  
25 generally the western part of precinct 15 which extends from the precinct boundary  
26 and the City of Rockville boundary west to the intersection with the B&O Railroad,  
27 then north–northwest along the B&O Railroad to the precinct boundary;

28                   9. That part of election district 4, precinct 19 that is  
29 generally the western part of precinct 19 which extends from the precinct boundary  
30 south along the center of Beach Drive, then south along Park Boundary, then south  
31 along the center of Avery Road to the precinct boundary;

32                   10. That part of election district 4, precinct 27 that is  
33 generally the western part of precinct 27 which extends from the precinct boundary  
34 east–northeast along the City of Rockville boundary to its intersection with Twinbrook

1 Parkway, then north–northeast along the center of Twinbrook Parkway to the precinct  
2 boundary;

3 11. That part of election district 6, precinct 3 that is  
4 generally the center part of precinct 3 which extends from the precinct boundary west  
5 along the center of Great Seneca Highway to the precinct boundary, then south along  
6 the precinct boundary to its intersection with Great Seneca Creek, then  
7 east–southeast along the Great Seneca Creek to the precinct boundary;

8 12. That part of election district 9, precinct 2 that is  
9 generally the southern part of precinct 2 which extends from the precinct boundary  
10 north along the center of Shady Grove Road to its intersection with the City of  
11 Rockville boundary, then north on the City of Rockville boundary to the precinct  
12 boundary; and

13 13. That part of election district 9, precinct 6 that is  
14 generally the southern part of precinct 6 which extends from the precinct boundary  
15 south along the center of the Interstate 270 exit for Fields Road to the center of Fields  
16 Road, then east along the center of Fields Road to a point just west of Winners Road,  
17 then north staying just west of Winners Road to Washington Boulevard, then along  
18 the center of Washington Boulevard to its intersection with Rio Boulevard, then south  
19 along the center of Rio Boulevard to its intersection with Fields Road, then west along  
20 the center of Fields Road to the intersection at Sam Eig Highway, then continues west  
21 to the center of Crown Farm Road, then proceeds west along the center of Crown Farm  
22 Road to the intersection of Watch Hill Lane, then along a line just northwest of Crown  
23 Farm Road moves north and west to Story Drive and the intersection of County Court,  
24 then south along the center of Story Drive to the intersection with Diamondback  
25 Drive, then east along the center of Diamondback Drive to the intersection of Sam Eig  
26 Highway, then south along the center of Sam Eig Highway to the City of Gaithersburg  
27 boundary, then south and west along the City of Gaithersburg boundary to the  
28 precinct boundary.

29 (vi) Board of Education District 3 consists of:

30 1. Election district 4, precincts 4, 8, 10, 13, 18, 24, 26,  
31 28, and 31;

32 2. Election district 7;

33 3. Election district 10, precincts 7, 10, and 11;

34 4. Election district 13, precincts 3, 7, 16, 26, 27, 34, 38,  
35 39, 40, and 62;

36 5. That part of election district 4, precinct 15 that is  
37 generally the eastern part of precinct 15 which extends from the precinct boundary

1 and the City of Rockville boundary north–northwest to the intersection with B&O  
2 Railroad then east along the B&O Railroad to the precinct boundary;

3           6. That part of election district 4, precinct 27 that is  
4 generally the eastern part of precinct 27 which extends from the precinct boundary  
5 east–northeast along the City of Rockville boundary to its intersection with Twinbrook  
6 Parkway, then north–northeast along the center of Twinbrook Parkway to the precinct  
7 boundary; and

8           7. That part of election district 13, precinct 10 that is  
9 generally the western part of precinct 10 which extends from the precinct boundary  
10 and the county boundary and goes north–northwest along the center of 16th Street to  
11 the precinct boundary.

20 along the center of Wintingham Drive to Hawkesbury Lane, then south along the  
21 center of Hawkesbury Lane to the precinct boundary;

22           3. That part of election district 13, precinct 10 that is  
23 generally the eastern part of precinct 10 which extends from the precinct boundary  
24 and the county boundary and goes north–northwest along the center of 16th Street to  
25 the precinct boundary;

26           4. That part of election district 13, precinct 49 that is  
27 generally the southwestern part of precinct 49 which extends from the precinct  
28 boundary north–northeast along the center of Baileys Lane to the precinct boundary;

32 boundary east–southeast along the center of Park Vista Drive to Layhill Road, then

11 (2) Before removing a member, the County Council shall provide the  
12 member a copy of the charges against him and give him an opportunity within 10 days  
13 to request a hearing.

14 (3) If the member requests a hearing within the 10-day period:

15 (i) The County Council promptly shall hold a hearing, but a  
16 hearing may not be set within 10 days after the County Council sends the member a  
17 notice of the hearing; and

18 (ii) The member shall have an opportunity to be heard publicly  
19 before the County Council in the member's own defense, in person or by counsel.

20 (4) A member removed under this subsection has the right to a de  
21 novo review of the removal by the Circuit Court for Montgomery County.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency  
23 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,  
24 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members  
25 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from  
26 the date it is enacted.
