A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore County and Frederick County – Career Activities in Public High**
3 **Schools – Sale of Coffee by Students With Individualized Education Programs**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting an Executive Branch agency from banning or regulating
5 the sale of coffee in conjunction with a career exploration and development activity
6 created for or organized by students with individualized education programs in a
7 public high school in Baltimore County or Frederick County; repealing a certain
8 exception that prohibited the sale of coffee in certain public high schools in Baltimore
9 County except under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the sale of
10 coffee in conjunction with a career exploration and development activity in public
11 high schools in Baltimore County and Frederick County.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Education**

20 7–423.1.

21 (a) This section applies only in Baltimore County **AND FREDERICK COUNTY**.

22 (b) [Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, an] **AN** Executive Branch
23 agency may **NOT** ban or regulate the sale of coffee in conjunction with a career exploration
24 and development activity **CREATED FOR OR ORGANIZED BY STUDENTS WITH**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAMS** in a public high school.

2 [(c) An Executive Branch agency may not ban or regulate the sale of coffee in
3 conjunction with a career exploration and development activity in a public high school that
4 sold coffee on or before June 30, 2018.]

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
6 1, 2023.
