BY adding to Article – Transportation Section 8-657 Annotated Code of Maryland (2015 Replacement Volume and 2015 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article – Transportation** 8-657. (A) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL DEVELOP AND MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC ON ITS WEB SITE IN AN ACCESSIBLE AND SEARCHABLE ELECTRONIC
