- FOR the purpose of altering the number of votes to which a declarant is entitled when voting on a homeowners association matter before and after any lot that may be part of the development is subdivided and recorded under certain circumstances; and

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law or any provision in the declaration, bylaws, rules, deeds, agreements, or recorded covenants or restrictions of a homeowners association, beginning on the date on which [all lots] ANY LOT that may be part of the development [have] HAS been subdivided and recorded in the land records of the county in which the homeowners association is located, the declarant, when voting on a homeowners association matter, shall be entitled to one vote per lot that:
- 22 (1) Has been subdivided and recorded in the land records of the county in which the homeowners association is located; and



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- 1 (2) Has not been sold to members of the public.
 - (b) Before the date on which [all lots] ANY LOT that may be part of the development [have] HAS been subdivided and recorded in the land records of the county in which the homeowners association is located, the declarant, when voting on a homeowners association matter, shall be entitled to the number of votes set forth in the governing documents of the homeowners association.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2020.
