1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Alcoholic Beverages – Hard Cider – Definition**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of hard cider to include certain beverages
4 derived primarily from pears or pear concentrate and water; and generally
5 relating to the definition of hard cider.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

19 1–102.

1 (a) (1) In this article the following words have the meanings indicated.

2 (9–1) “Hard cider” means a beverage derived primarily from [apples or]
3 **APPLES**, apple concentrate and water, **PEARS, OR PEAR CONCENTRATE AND**
4 **WATER**, containing no other fruit product, and containing at least one–half of 1% and
5 less than 7% of alcohol by volume.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 October 1, 2014.
