A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Commissioner of Labor and Industry – Enforcement of Orders – Central**
3 **Collection Unit**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Commissioner of Labor and Industry to authorize
5 the Central Collection Unit to proceed in the District Court to enforce payment
6 of certain orders under certain circumstances; specifying that this Act does not
7 affect a certain provision of law; and generally relating to the enforcement of
8 orders issued by the Commissioner of Labor and Industry.

10 Article – Labor and Employment

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Labor and Employment**

17 **2–107.1.**

18 **(A) IF A CIVIL PENALTY ASSESSED OR MONEY DUE UNDER AN ORDER**
19 **ISSUED BY THE COMMISSIONER IS NOT PAID IN FULL WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER**
20 **THE ORDER BECOMES FINAL, THE COMMISSIONER MAY AUTHORIZE THE**
21 **CENTRAL COLLECTION UNIT TO PROCEED IN THE DISTRICT COURT TO**
22 **ENFORCE PAYMENT.**

23 **(B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT AFFECT § 5–811 OF THIS ARTICLE.**

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 2012.
