A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Health – Sale and Distribution of Products Containing NMP and DCM –**
3 **Prohibition**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting, on or after a certain date, the sale or distribution of any
5 paint or coating removal product that contains N–Methylpyrrolidone or methylene
6 chloride, also known as dichloromethane; establishing a certain penalty for a certain
7 violation; and generally relating to a prohibition on the sale or distribution of
8 products that contain N–Methylpyrrolidone or methylene chloride.

11 Section 24–308
12 Annotated Code of Maryland

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Health – General**

17 **24–308.**

18 (A) ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2021, A PERSON MAY NOT SELL OR
19 DISTRIBUTE IN COMMERCE ANY PAINT OR COATING REMOVAL PRODUCT THAT
20 CONTAINS N–METHYLPYRROLIDONE (NMP) OR METHYLENE CHLORIDE, ALSO
21 KNOWN AS DICHLOROMETHANE (DCM).

22 (B) A PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION OR ANY REGULATION
23 ADOPTED BY THE SECRETARY TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

1 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000
2 FOR EACH VIOLATION.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
4 October 1, 2019.
