- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article Education
- 16 3–901.
- 17 (a) (1) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

<u>Underlining</u> indicates amendments to bill.

Strike out indicates matter stricken from the bill by amendment or deleted from the law by amendment.

- 1 "Board of Education District" means a geographic area of Montgomery (2)2 County in which an elected member of the Montgomery County Board of Education must 3 be a legal resident. The geographic area of each district is described in subsection (f) of this 4 section. Each district shall be substantially equal in population, and the districts shall be reapportioned on the basis of each decennial census of the United States. 5 6 "Elected member" means 1 of the 7 elected and voting members of the 7 Montgomery County Board or a member appointed to fill a vacancy of 1 of these 7 members.
- 8 The Montgomery County Board consists of: (b)
- 9 (1) 5 elected members, each of whom resides in a different board of 10 education district;
- 11 (2) 2 elected members who may reside anywhere in the county; and
- 12 (3)1 student member.
- 13 An elected member of the county board shall be a registered voter of 14 Montgomery County.
- 15 Members of the Montgomery County Board shall be elected at the general election every 2 years as required by subsection (f) of this section. 16
- 17 The student member shall be a bona fide resident of Montgomery (e) 18 County and a regularly enrolled junior or senior year student from a Montgomery County 19 public high school.
- 20 (2)The nomination and election process shall be as agreed on by the county 21board and the Montgomery County region of the Maryland Association of Student Councils. This agreement shall include a process by which to replace one or both of the final 2223 candidates if they are unable to proceed in the election. Any student enrolled in a middle 24or high school in the Montgomery County public schools may:
- 25 Nominate a student member candidate: (i)
- 26 Vote for delegates from the student's school, who in turn vote in 27 a nominating convention to reduce to 2 the number of candidates for student member if 28 there are 3 or more candidates; and
- 29 (iii) Vote directly for 1 of the 2 remaining student member 30 candidates.
- 31 The candidate receiving the second highest number of votes in the 32 direct election shall become the alternate student member. The alternate shall serve if the 33 student member is unable to complete his elected term.

- 1 (4) Except as provided in paragraphs (5), (6), and (7) of this subsection, the student member has the same rights and privileges of an elected member.
- 3 (5) Unless invited to attend by the affirmative vote of a majority of the 4 county board, the student member may not attend an executive session that relates to 5 hearings held under § 6–202(a) of this article.
- 6 (6) As provided in paragraph (7) of this subsection, the student member 7 shall vote on all matters except those relating to § 6–202(a) of this article.
- 8 (7) On a majority vote of the elected members, the county board may 9 determine, on a case by case basis, whether a matter under consideration is covered by the 10 exclusionary provision in paragraph (6) of this subsection.
- 11 (f) (1) Each elected member serves for a term of 4 years beginning on 12 December 1 after the member's election and until a successor is elected and qualifies. The 13 terms of elected members are staggered as required by the terms of the members serving 14 on the county board as of July 1, 1978 so that 4 members are elected in gubernatorial 15 election years and 3 members are elected in presidential election years.
- 16 (2) Elected members of the county board shall be elected by the voters of the entire county.
- 18 (3) (i) Of the 3 members elected in 1992 and every 4 years thereafter, 1 19 shall reside in Board of Education District 2 and 1 shall reside in Board of Education 20 District 4. The third member may reside in any part of the county.
- 21 (ii) Of the 4 members elected in 1990 and every 4 years thereafter, 1 22 shall reside in Board of Education District 1, 1 shall reside in Board of Education District 23 3, and 1 shall reside in Board of Education District 5. The fourth member may reside in 24 any part of the county.
- 25 (iii) The descriptions of board of education districts in this subsection 26 refer to the geographical boundaries of the election districts and the precincts:
- 1. As reviewed and certified by the Montgomery County Board of Elections or its designees, before the precinct boundaries were reported to the U.S. Bureau of the Census as part of the [2010] **2020** Census Redistricting Data Program; and
- 30 2. As those precinct lines are specifically shown on the P.L. 31 94–171 census block maps provided by the U.S. Bureau of the Census and as reviewed and 32 corrected by the Division of [Long-range] CAPITAL Planning AND REAL ESTATE of the 33 Montgomery County Public Schools.
- I(iv) Where precincts are split between Board of Education Districts, census tract and block numbers, as indicated in the P.L. 94–171 data or shown on the P.L. 171 census block maps provided by the U.S. Bureau of the Census and referred to in this

- 1 subtitle, are used to define the boundaries of the education districts.

- 23 10. That part of election district 9, precinct 1 that is generally the northern part of precinct 1 which extends from the precinct boundary east along the center of CSX railroad tracks to the precinct boundary;
- 11. That part of election district 9, precinct 8 that is generally the eastern part of precinct 8 which extends from the precinct boundary southeast along the center of Wisteria Drive, then southwest along the center of Great Seneca Highway to the precinct boundary;
- 30 12. That part of election district 9, precinct 10 that is 31 generally the northern part of precinct 10 which extends from the precinct boundary 32 northeast along the center of Washington Grove Lane to the precinct boundary;
  - 13. That part of election district 9, precinct 16 that is
