State Lottery - Licenses - Veterans' Organizations

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Director of the State Lottery Agency to issue to certain veterans' organizations a license for not more than a certain number of 4 5 instant ticket lottery machines for the sale of certain lottery machine tickets 6 under certain circumstances; exempting certain counties from certain 7 provisions; requiring a veterans' organization to locate and operate certain 8 instant ticket lottery machines in certain places; authorizing the Director to 9 adopt certain regulations; providing that revenues from certain lottery machine ticket sales by a veterans' organization are to be credited to the State Lottery 10 Fund after certain deductions are made; requiring the Comptroller to distribute 11 a certain percentage of proceeds deposited in the State Lottery Fund from 12 13 certain lottery machine ticket sales by veterans' organizations to the Maryland 14 Veterans Trust Fund; requiring a veterans' organization issued a license under 15 this Act to purchase or lease instant ticket lottery machines; prohibiting a 16 veterans' organization from using certain lottery receipts to pay certain costs for 17 instant ticket lottery machines; defining a certain term; directing the State Lottery Agency to ensure that implementation of the provisions of this Act with 18 19 respect to the conduct of gaming and the operation of the instant ticket lottery 20 machines is consistent with a certain court decision; and generally relating to 21 the State lottery and certain lottery machine ticket sales by veterans' 22 organizations.
