2 **State Retirement and Pension System – Military Service Credit – Eligibility**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the criteria used to determine the eligibility of certain
4 members of the State Retirement and Pension System to receive service credit
5 for military service so as to require a certain amount of service credit in the
6 State Retirement and Pension System in a certain manner; and generally
7 relating to eligibility criteria for certain members of the State Retirement and
8 Pension System to receive service credit for military service.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, an individual
19 described in subsection (a) of this section, who has not met the conditions set forth in §
20 38–103(a)(2) through (4) of this subtitle, is entitled to receive service credit for military
