CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Bike Lanes and Shoulders – Yielding Right-of-Way**
3 **(Sarah Debbink Langenkamp Memorial Act)**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from committing a violation ~~that contributes to a~~
5 ~~crash~~ of a certain provision of law governing the right-of-way of a bicycle, a motor
6 scooter, or an electronic personal assistive mobility device lawfully in a designated
7 bike lane or shoulder that contributes to the serious physical injury or death of a
8 person riding a bicycle, EPAMD, or motor scooter; and generally relating to yielding
9 the right-of-way in a bike lane or shoulder.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Transportation**

18 21–1209.

19 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, the driver of a vehicle shall:

1 (1) Exercise due care to avoid colliding with any bicycle, EPAMD, or motor
2 scooter being ridden by a person; and

3 (2) When overtaking a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor scooter, pass safely
4 at a distance of not less than 3 feet, unless, at the time:

5 (i) The bicycle, EPAMD, or motor scooter rider fails to operate the
6 vehicle in conformance with § 21–1205(a) of this subtitle (“Riding to right side of roadway”) or § 21–1205.1(b) of this subtitle (“Roadway with bike lane or shoulder paved to smooth
7 surface”);

9 (ii) A passing clearance of less than 3 feet is caused solely by the
10 bicycle, EPAMD, or motor scooter rider failing to maintain a steady course; or

11 (iii) The highway on which the vehicle is being driven is not wide
12 enough to lawfully pass the bicycle, EPAMD, or motor scooter at a distance of at least 3
13 feet.

14 (b) A person may not throw any object at or in the direction of any person riding
15 a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor scooter.

16 (c) A person may not open the door of any motor vehicle with intent to strike,
17 injure, or interfere with any person riding a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor scooter.

18 (d) (1) Unless otherwise specified in this title, the driver of a vehicle shall yield
19 the right-of-way to a person who is lawfully riding a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor scooter
20 in a designated bike lane or shoulder if the driver of the vehicle is about to enter or cross
21 the designated bike lane or shoulder.

22 (2) (I) A PERSON MAY NOT COMMIT A VIOLATION OF PARAGRAPH
23 (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION THAT CONTRIBUTES TO ~~A CRASH~~ THE SERIOUS PHYSICAL
24 INJURY OR DEATH OF A PERSON RIDING A BICYCLE, EPAMD, OR MOTOR SCOOTER.

25 (II) A PERSON CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF SUBPARAGRAPH
26 (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 2 MONTHS
27 OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$2,000 OR BOTH.

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
29 October 1, 2024.
