- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain residential leases between the Maryland Economic $\mathbf{5}$ Development Corporation and certain students living in student housing owned by 6 the Corporation to be presented in a certain manner and include a certain notice; 7 requiring the Corporation to give certain notice and abide by certain protocols 8 regarding University System of Maryland students living in student housing owned 9 by the Corporation if the University closes the institution or center the student 10 attends due to a health or safety emergency; and generally relating to the Maryland 11 Economic Development Corporation and requirements for student housing.

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"HEALTH OR SAFETY EMERGENCY" MEANS AN IMMINENT THREAT 1 (5) $\mathbf{2}$ OR OCCURRENCE OF SEVERE OR WIDESPREAD LOSS OF LIFE, INJURY, OR OTHER 3 HEALTH IMPACTS, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR DESTRUCTION, SOCIAL OR ECONOMIC 4 OR **ENVIRONMENTAL** DEGRADATION DISRUPTION, FROM NATURAL, $\mathbf{5}$ TECHNOLOGICAL, OR HUMAN-MADE CAUSES.

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- (6) "STUDENT-RESIDENT" MEANS A STUDENT WHO:

7 (I) IS ENROLLED AT A CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION OR A 8 CENTER; AND

9 (II) ENTERS INTO A RESIDENTIAL LEASE WITH THE 10 CORPORATION TO LIVE IN A CORPORATION STUDENT HOUSING PROJECT.

11 **(B)** This section applies only to a Corporation student housing 12 **PROJECT AT A CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION OR A CENTER.**

13 (C) IF THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF MARYLAND CLOSES A CONSTITUENT 14 INSTITUTION OR A CENTER DUE TO A HEALTH OR SAFETY EMERGENCY, THE 15 CORPORATION SHALL:

16 (1) GIVE STUDENT-RESIDENTS THE SAME NOTICE TO VACATE THAT IS 17 GIVEN TO A RESIDENT OF STUDENT HOUSING OWNED BY THE CONSTITUENT 18 INSTITUTION OR CENTER; AND

19 (2) ABIDE BY THE SAME LEASE RELEASE PROTOCOLS THAT ARE IN 20 PLACE FOR A RESIDENT OF STUDENT HOUSING OWNED BY THE CONSTITUENT 21 INSTITUTION OR CENTER.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any student-housing contracts entered into by the Maryland Economic Development Corporation before the effective date of this Act.

26 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 27 1, 2022.
