- 1 (B) A PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL PENALTY NOT EXCEEDING \$200 FOR EACH PACKAGE OF CIGARETTES SOLD OR OFFERED FOR SALE IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION.
- 4 (C) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL MAY BRING AN ACTION TO ENJOIN AN 5 ACT IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION AND TO RECOVER CIVIL PENALTIES 6 AUTHORIZED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 January 1, 2015.
