1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Pathways in Technology Early College High (P-TECH) Expansion Act of 2019**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the limit on the number of Pathways in Technology Early
4 College High (P-TECH) Planning Grants that may be awarded to a local school
5 system in each year; removing the prohibition against new P-TECH Planning
6 Grants being awarded to establish a new P-TECH school until a certain condition is
7 met; repealing certain intent language; and generally relating to the Pathways in
8 Technology Early College High School Program.
