- 3 FOR the purpose of limiting the authority of the Baltimore City Board of Municipal and 4 Zoning Appeals to hear and decide certain appeals to instances when the Board is 5 authorized to hear and decide the appeals by the Mayor and City Council of 6 Baltimore City by local law or the Charter of Baltimore City; stating that this Act 7 does not prohibit an administrative official or unit from making a certain decision 8 when authorized by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City by local law or the 9 Charter of Baltimore City; establishing that this Act does not alter or impair the right to appeal provided for under certain provisions of law; and generally relating 10 11 to Baltimore City zoning.
