- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Director of the Office of Cemetery Oversight to 5 grant to certain persons subject to certain trust requirements under certain 6 provisions of law a certain extension of time in which to file certain reports 7 relating to the perpetual care trust fund of a cemetery and the preneed burial 8 contracts trust account of a seller of preneed goods and services; clarifying 9 language; making a stylistic change; and generally relating to cemeteries and report filing deadlines for perpetual care and preneed burial contract trust 10 11 accounts.


