2	Motor Vehicle Administration - Traffic Control Signal Monitoring Systems -

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Motor Vehicle Administration to enter into a certain agreement with another jurisdiction for the reciprocal enforcement of traffic violations recorded by a traffic control signal monitoring system under certain circumstances; requiring a political subdivision to coordinate with the Administration to facilitate the reciprocal enforcement of violations recorded by a traffic control signal monitoring system; and generally relating to reciprocal agreements between the State and other jurisdictions for the enforcement of

violations recorded by traffic control signal monitoring systems.



30 (d) (1) Unless the driver of the motor vehicle received a citation from a police 31 officer at the time of the violation, the owner or, in accordance with subsection (g)(5) of this

- 1 section, the driver of a motor vehicle is subject to a civil penalty if the motor vehicle is 2recorded by a traffic control signal monitoring system while being operated in violation of
- 3 § 21–202(h) of this subtitle.

- 2 THE PENALTY FOR A VIOLATION RECORDED BY A TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAL
- 3 MONITORING SYSTEM IN THE STATE BY MORE THAN 50%.
- 4 (F) A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION FOR WHICH A TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAL
- 5 MONITORING SYSTEM IS OPERATED AND MAINTAINED AT AN INTERSECTION UNDER
- 6 THE CONTROL OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION SHALL COORDINATE WITH THE
- 7 ADMINISTRATION TO FACILITATE THE RECIPROCAL ENFORCEMENT OF VIOLATIONS
