3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the Treasurer of St. Mary's County, the
4 Sheriff of St. Mary's County, the Judges of the Orphans' Court for St. Mary's
5 County, the President of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Mary's
6 County, and the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County; providing that
7 this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the Treasurer of St.
8 Mary's County, Sheriff of St. Mary's County, Judges of the Orphans' Court for
9 St. Mary's County, President of the Board of County Commissioners of St.
10 Mary's County, and County Commissioners of St. Mary's County during a
11 certain term of office; and generally relating to the salaries of public officials of
12 St. Mary's County.

9 (3) The Attorney to the County Commissioners shall receive an annual
 10 salary as determined by the Commissioners.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §
 12 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to
 13 the salary or compensation of the Treasurer of St. Mary’s County, the Sheriff of St.
 14 Mary’s County, the Judges of the Orphans’ Court for St. Mary’s County, the President
 15 of the Board of County Commissioners of St. Mary’s County, or the County
 16 Commissioners of St. Mary’s County during a term of office beginning before the
 17 effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or
 18 compensation of the Treasurer of St. Mary’s County, the Sheriff of St. Mary’s County,
 19 the Judges of the Orphans’ Court for St. Mary’s County, the President of the Board of
 20 County Commissioners of St. Mary’s County, and the County Commissioners of St.
 21 Mary’s County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

22 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 23 October 1, 2013.
