1 AN ACT concerning

2 Natural Resources – Licenses, Permits, Registrations, and Certificates – Digital 3 or Electronic Format and Stamps – Revisions

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to make available and, 5 on request, issue certain licenses. permits, registrations, and certificates and stamps 6 in a digital or electronic format; establishing that an individual may satisfy certain 7 requirements to possess or display a license, permit, registration, or certificate or 8 stamp by possessing or displaying the document in a certain digital or electronic 9 format; requiring the Department to design certain digital or electronic documents 10 in a certain manner prohibiting certain applicants from willfully making a certain 11 false statement or representation; repealing certain provisions of law requiring certain licensees to sign a license in a certain manner at a certain time; making a 12 stylistic change; and generally relating to licenses, permits, registrations, and 13 certificates and stamps issued by the Department of Natural Resources. 14

16 17 18	(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this article, the Department may develop and implement an electronic system for the sale and issuance of licenses, permits, and registrations and the recording and releasing of security interests.
19	(b) The electronic system may include provisions for:
20	(1) Recording titling and registration data;
21 22	(2) Recording and releasing liens without the issuance of a security interest filing; and
23 24	(3) Recording information relating to an application for a license, permit, or registration.
25 26 27	(c) The Department shall develop the electronic system consistent with the statewide information technology master plan developed under Title 3A, Subtitle 3 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
28	(g) The Department may adopt regulations to:
29	(1) Implement the electronic system authorized under this section; and
30 31	(2) Determine the appropriate fee levels that may be charged by a vendor and by the Department for the electronic transmission service.

- (B) (1) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY SATISFY ANY REQUIREMENT UNDER THIS
 ARTICLE TO POSSESS OR DISPLAY A HICENSE, PERMIT, REGISTRATION, OR
 CERTIFICATE LICENSE OR STAMP ISSUED UNDER §§ 4–604, 4–614, 4–745, OR
 10–301(G) OF THIS ARTICLE BY POSSESSING OR DISPLAYING THE DOCUMENT IN A
 DIGITAL OR ELECTRONIC FORMAT AS PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 10 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DESIGN THE DIGITAL OR ELECTRONIC
 11 DOCUMENTS AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SECTION IN A MANNER THAT ALLOWS THE
 12 DOCUMENT HOLDER TO MAINTAIN PHYSICAL POSSESSION OF THE DEVICE ON WHICH
 13 THE DOCUMENT IS ACCESSED DURING VERIFICATION.

- (e) (1) An applicant for a license issued under this section [shall]:
- 16 (I) SHALL provide all the information requested by the 17 Department; AND
- 18 (II) MAY NOT WILLFULLY MAKE A FALSE STATEMENT OR
 19 REPRESENTATION TO THE DEPARTMENT ON THE APPLICATION.
- 20 (2) The Department shall require an applicant for a license under this section to provide the last four digits of the applicant's Social Security number, if the applicant has a Social Security number.
- 23 (h) (1) Every angler's license shall be valid for 1 year following the date of 24 issuance.
- 25 (2) [The licensee shall electronically or physically sign the license at the time of purchase.
- 27 (3) The license may not be transferred to another person, nor used or presented by any person other than the person to whom it was issued.

- 30 (a) (b) An applicant for a license issued under this section [shall]:

(I) SHALL provide all the information requested by the Department; AND
(II) MAY NOT WILLFULLY MAKE A FALSE STATEMENT OR REPRESENTATION TO THE DEPARTMENT ON THE APPLICATION.

(j) [The licensee shall electronically or physically sign the hunting license at the time the licensee obtains the hunting license. It] A HUNTING LICENSE may not be transferred to any other person.
