BY adding to Article – Transportation Section 15–304(g) Annotated Code of Maryland (2020 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Transportation 15-304.

It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and 8 months and, at the end of May 31, 2027, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
