A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Chesapeake Bay Bridge Crossing – Eastern Shore Local Government Consent –**
3 **Repeal**

4 FOR the purpose of providing that a requirement that certain governments of certain
5 counties affected by the construction of a toll road, toll highway, or toll bridge consent
6 to the construction does not apply to the construction of a toll road, toll highway, or
7 toll bridge crossing the Chesapeake Bay; and generally relating to a toll road, toll
8 highway, or toll bridge crossing the Chesapeake Bay.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 (a) This section applies to:

19 (1) Caroline County;

20 (2) Cecil County;

21 (3) Dorchester County;

22 (4) Kent County;

6 (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A TOLL ROAD, TOLL HIGHWAY, OR
7 TOLL BRIDGE CROSSING THE CHESAPEAKE BAY.

8 [(b)] (C) A State agency, including the Maryland Transportation Authority, may
9 not construct any toll road, toll highway, or toll bridge in the counties enumerated in this
10 section without the express consent of a majority of the governments of the affected
11 counties.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 October 1, 2018.
