A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County – Alcoholic Beverages – Class A/Class 4 Light Wine**
3 **Licenses**

5 FOR the purpose of authorizing a Class A light wine license to be issued in Prince
6 George's County; exempting a winery that applies for a certain license from
7 certain quotas; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Prince
8 George's County.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
10 Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages
11 Section 4–201(a) and (c)
12 Annotated Code of Maryland
13 (2005 Replacement Volume and 2009 Supplement)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

17 4–201.

18 (a) A Class A light wine license may be issued only in:

19 (1) Anne Arundel County;

20 (2) Baltimore County;

21 (3) Calvert County;

19 (e) (1) A Class A light wine license may be issued by the license issuing
20 authority of the county in which the place of business is located to any holder of a
21 Class 4 manufacturer's license.

22 (2) A winery in Cecil County that applies for a Class A/Class 4 license
23 is exempt from any quotas established by the Cecil County Board of License
24 Commissioners as to the number of licenses in the election district where the winery is
25 located.

26 (3) A winery in Baltimore County that applies for a Class A/Class 4
27 license is exempt from any quotas established by the Baltimore County Board of

1 License Commissioners as to the number of licenses in the election district where the
2 winery is located.

3 **(4) A WINERY IN PRINCE GEORGE’S COUNTY THAT APPLIES FOR**
4 **A CLASS A/CLASS 4 LICENSE IS EXEMPT FROM ANY QUOTAS ESTABLISHED BY**
5 **THE PRINCE GEORGE’S COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS AS TO**
6 **THE NUMBER OF LICENSES IN THE ELECTION DISTRICT WHERE THE WINERY IS**
7 **LOCATED.**

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 July 1, 2010.
