FOR the purpose of establishing a Task Force to Study the Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission in Prince George's County; providing for the membership, appointment, responsibilities, and staffing of the Task Force; requiring the Task Force to submit certain reports to certain persons by certain dates; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Task Force to Study the Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission in Prince George's County.				
SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(2) "Commission" means the Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission.				
(3) "County" means Prince George's County.				
(4) "Task Force" means the Task Force to Study the Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission in Prince George's County.

- 17 (f) The Task Force shall submit to the Governor, the County Executive of Prince George's County, the Prince George's County Council, the Prince George's County Municipal Association, and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the Prince George's County Senators and the Prince George's County Delegation of the House of Delegates:
- 22 (1) on or before October 1, 2010, a preliminary report of its proceedings, with any appropriate findings and recommendations; and
- 24 (2) on or before October 1, 2011, a final report of its findings and 25 recommendations.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2010. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of May 31, 2012, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
