1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

7 THE COMMISSION MAY ~~ENTER A BUILDING OR PREMISES~~ ENTER ON REAL  
8 PROPERTY, THE COMMON AREA OF A MULTIFAMILY BUILDING, OR A  
9 COMMERCIAL BUILDING THAT HAS A CONNECTION WITH THE WATER SUPPLY OR  
10 SEWER SYSTEM UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE COMMISSION AT A  
11 REASONABLE TIME TO POST A NOTICE ON OR NEAR THE ENTRY DOOR OF THE  
12 BUILDING OR PREMISES UNIT THAT INFORMS CUSTOMERS OF PROJECT  
13 INFORMATION AND CONSTRUCTION RELATED EVENTS THAT ARE BEING  
14 PROPOSED OR IMPLEMENTED, INCLUDING TEMPORARY SERVICE  
15 INTERRUPTIONS AND CONSTRUCTION START UP DATES WOULD INFORM THE  
16 OWNER OR OCCUPANT OF ANY OFFICIAL COMMISSION BUSINESS THAT AFFECTS  
17 EITHER THE PUBLIC OR THAT PARTICULAR PROPERTY.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
19 October 1, 2010.
