14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Chapter 593 of the Acts of 1996, as amended by Chapter 566 of the Acts of**
17 **1999, Chapter 370 of the Acts of 2002, Chapter 401 of the Acts of 2005, and**
18 **Chapters 572 and 573 of the Acts of 2008**

19 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, this Act shall take
20 effect October 1, 1996. It shall remain effective for a period of [15] 20 years and, at
