5 FOR the purpose of requiring the Prince George's County Board of Education to install an 6 outdoor synthetic turf field at each public high school in the county during a certain period of time; establishing the priority order for school field construction; 7 8 prohibiting the Prince George's County Executive and the Prince George's County 9 Board of Education from designating more than a certain number of fields for 10 construction in any fiscal year; requiring certain fields to be constructed for joint use; 11 requiring certain expenditures to be deemed eligible public school construction costs 12 or capital improvement costs by the Interagency Committee on School Construction 13 for certain purposes; requiring the local share of costs for construction of certain 14 fields to be paid for with certain funds from Program Open Space; authorizing the 15 Prince George's County Board of Education to use certain funds to implement certain 16 provisions of law; and generally relating to public high school athletic fields and the 17 Prince George's County Board of Education.
