1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Talbot County – Zoning Regulations – Enforcement**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the legislative body of Talbot County to provide by  
4 local law for an administrative proceeding to enforce certain zoning regulations;  
5 allowing the local law to include certain authority to impose certain fines and  
6 penalties for zoning violations; *making a conforming change*; and generally  
7 relating to the enforcement of zoning regulations in Talbot County.

8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
 9 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 (b) The following provisions of this division apply to a charter county:

13 (17) for Howard County only, Title 9, Subtitle 13 (Single-County  
 14 Provisions – Howard County); [and]

15 (18) FOR TALBOT COUNTY ONLY, TITLE 9, SUBTITLE 18  
 16 (SINGLE-COUNTY PROVISIONS – TALBOT COUNTY); AND

17 [(18)] (19) Title 11, Subtitle 2 (Civil Penalty).

22 **(A) IN ADDITION TO THE JURISDICTION GRANTED IN TITLE 11 OF THIS**  
 23 **ARTICLE, THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF TALBOT COUNTY MAY PROVIDE BY LOCAL**  
 24 **LAW FOR AN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING TO ENFORCE ITS ZONING**  
 25 **REGULATIONS.**

26 **(B) THE LOCAL LAW MAY INCLUDE THE AUTHORITY TO IMPOSE CIVIL**  
 27 **FINES AND PENALTIES FOR ZONING VIOLATIONS.**

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
 29 October 1, 2012.
