1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Fire, Rescue, or Emergency Medical Services Entities – Resale of Admission**
3 **Tickets**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from selling or offering for sale an admission
5 ticket to a certain event held for the benefit of a fire, a rescue, or an emergency
6 services entity at a greater price than that printed on the ticket; providing for a
7 certain penalty; and generally relating to fire, rescue, and emergency services
8 entities.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Public Safety**

17 **7–404.**

18 **(A) A PERSON MAY NOT SELL OR OFFER FOR SALE AN ADMISSION**
19 **TICKET TO A THEATER, A MUSICAL PERFORMANCE, OR ANY OTHER**
20 **ENTERTAINMENT EVENT HELD FOR THE BENEFIT OF A FIRE, A RESCUE, OR AN**

3 (B) (1) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
4 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING
5 \$500.

6 (2) EACH SALE OR OFFER FOR SALE IS A SEPARATE OFFENSE.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2011.
