- 16 (c) (1) Failure of the person alleged to be liable to pay the video toll under a
- 17 notice of toll due by the date stated on the notice shall constitute a toll violation subject to
- a civil citation and a civil penalty **OF \$25**, which shall be assessed 15 days after the toll
- 19 violation occurs [, as provided for in the regulations of the Authority].
- 20 (2) A registered owner of a motor vehicle [shall] MAY not be liable for a
- 21 civil penalty imposed under this section if the operator of the motor vehicle has been
- 22 convicted of failure or refusal to pay a toll under § 21–1413 of this subtitle for the same
- 23 violation.
