3 FOR the purpose of altering a certain authorization for certain Department of State Police

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Public Safety**

16 2–411.

17 (a) If authorized by the Secretary, ~~a police employee or a 40-hour civilian~~
18 ~~employee may work an alternative workday [of not more than 12 hours instead of an~~
19 ~~8-hour workday] AS APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY;~~

1 **(1) A POLICE EMPLOYEE MAY WORK AN ALTERNATIVE WORKDAY; OR**

2 **(2) A 40-HOUR CIVILIAN EMPLOYEE MAY WORK AN ALTERNATIVE**
3 **WORKDAY OF NOT MORE THAN 12 HOURS INSTEAD OF AN 8-HOUR WORKDAY.**

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
5 1, 2020.
