3 4 5 6 7 8 9	FOR the purpose of establishing the Task Force to Study Tax Sales in Maryland; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Task Force; prohibiting a member of the Task Force from receiving certain compensation but authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Task Force to study and make recommendations regarding certain matters; requiring the Task Force to report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Task Force to Study Tax Sales in Maryland.

14 15	WHEREAS, Local jurisdictions in the State are struggling with vacant and abandoned properties due to tax sales; and

The Task Force shall:

1 (b) The Task Force consists of the following members: 2 two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of (1) 3 the Senate; 4 (2)two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the House: 5 6 the Secretary of Housing and Community Development, or the (3)7 Secretary's designee; 8 **(4)** one member from Baltimore City, appointed by the Mayor of Baltimore 9 City; 10 one member from Dorchester County, appointed by the Dorchester (5)11 County Manager; 12 (6)one member from Prince George's County, appointed by the Prince 13 George's County Executive: one member appointed by the Maryland Association of Counties; 14 (7)one member appointed by the Maryland Municipal League; 15 (8)16 one member appointed by the Center for Community Progress; and (9)17 two members appointed by the Community Development Network of (10)Maryland. 18 19 (c) The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House shall designate the 20 chair of the Task Force. 21The Task Force may establish subcommittees it determines are necessary to (d) 22carry out its duties. 23 The Department of Housing and Community Development shall provide staff (e) for the Task Force. 24A member of the Task Force: 25 (f) 26 (1) may not receive compensation as a member of the Task Force; but 27 (2)is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State 28Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

5 6 7	(h) On or before December 1, 2017, the Task Force shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.
8	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2017. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 1 month and, at the end of June

30, 2018, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be

abrogated and of no further force and effect.
