3 FOR the purpose of providing that an applicant for registration to provide security systems
4 services may provide security systems services and have access to certain
5 information under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the provision of
6 security systems services.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Business Occupations and Professions**

15 18–3A–01.

16 Except as otherwise provided in this title:

17 (1) an individual may not personally provide security systems services
18 unless:

15 (3) neither a licensee nor a registrant may provide access to

17 **DOES NOT SATISFY THE REQUIREMENTS UNDER ITEM (2)(I) OR (II) OF THIS SECTION;**

19 (4) an employee of a person licensed under this title may not obtain access
20 to circumventational information unless:

21 **(I)** the employee is registered as an individual with access to
22 circumventational information; **OR**

23 **(II)** **1.** **THE EMPLOYEE HAS SUBMITTED AN APPLICATION**
24 **FOR REGISTRATION UNDER § 18-3A-03 OF THIS SUBTITLE AND RECEIVED AN**
25 **APPLICATION NUMBER THAT CONFIRMS RECEIPT; AND**

26 **2.** **THE EMPLOYEE'S APPLICATION HAS NOT BEEN**
27 **REJECTED.**
